Norwood has been involved in supporting this program for a number of years and this culminates in the Summer term with Year 2 and Year 6 children 'graduating' in a superb and memorable ceremony at Edge Hill.

While all the clubs that children go to in school are added in every half-term the outside school activities and visits can be recorded using a "Passport to Learning" available from the office at a cost of $\pounds 4$.
