

YEAR 5 MINI POLICE KEEPING ROADS SAFE FROM SPEEDING MOTORISTS




A group of our Year 5 Mini Police were very busy recently supporting Merseyside Police to take part in the NSPCC National Speed Campaign week of action in Ainsdale.
