CHILDREN ASPIRE WITH CHILDREN'S UNIVERSITY

Children's University is a national scheme to encourage children between 5 and 14 years to try new experiences, develop new interests and acquire new skills outside of the school day.

Children have a "Passport to Learning" to record their outside school activities with 'stamps' and hours of accredited learning. These "Passports" can be purchased from the school office priced £3 and are used through the whole of their primary school career.

Staff running extra-curricular clubs at Norwood also add credits from their clubs to the system so the more clubs children do, the more credits they will gain and the higher the certificate they will be awarded.

Every July children in Year 2 and Year 6 celebrate all the achievements in attending clubs inside and outside school by 'graduating' in a superb ceremony at Edge Hill University.

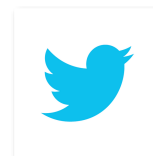
