

Dear Parents/Guardians,

Your child currently receives a portion of milk at school each day at snack time. Milk for under-fives is fully subsidised by the Department of Health under the Nursery Milk Scheme. This scheme enables children under 5 to receive a third-pint (189ml) portion of milk free of charge for each day they attend approved day care facilities for 2 hours or more.

Once your child reaches their fifth birthday this milk is only partially subsidised by the government. Your child may still receive a portion of milk each day but you are required to pay approximately 24p per portion for this.

If you would like your child to continue to receive milk after their fifth birthday you can register and arrange payment through the website below:

Once your payment has been received, our provider Cool Milk will arrange to have milk delivered each morning for your child.

If you receive certain benefits which entitle your child to Pupil Premium funding then we may be able to offer free milk for your child. If you are already paying for your milk, we can take over this payment. Please contact the office who will arrange this if your child is eligible.

Fresh water is always available for your child and if you are happy for your child to drink water at snack time then you do not need to take further action.
